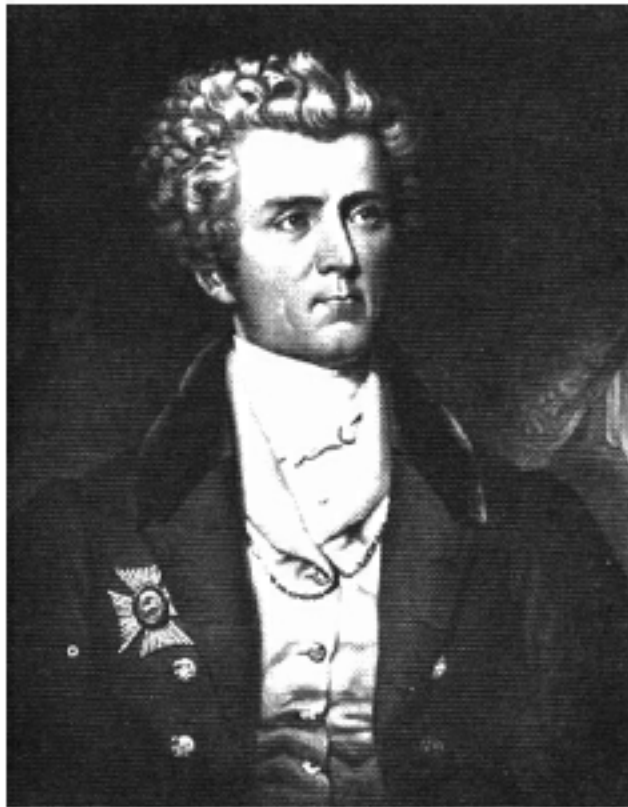
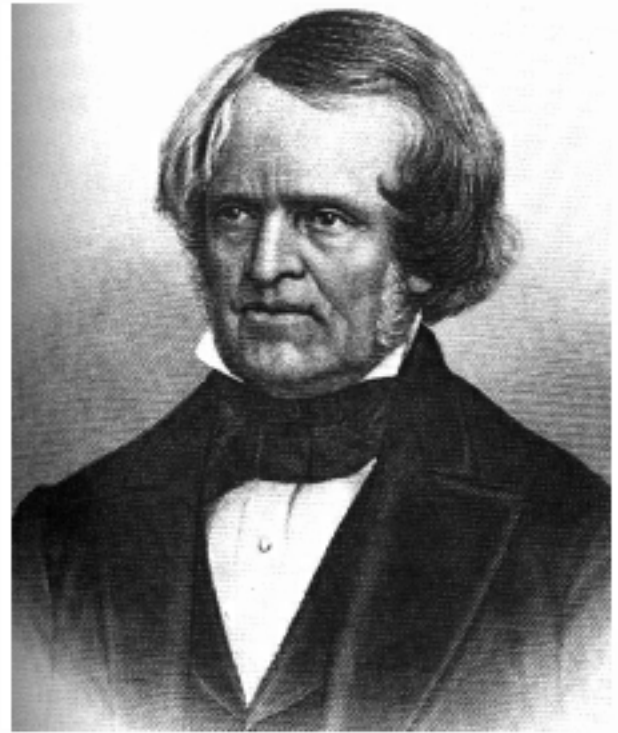
## **Lake Ontario Shippers & Travellers**

### **William Lyon Mackenzie**

A newspaper publisher who led a group that carried out the **Canada Rebellion** against Great Britain in 1838. His campaign was partially funded by friends and supporters in Rochester New York. Mackenzie was charged with treason by Lieutenant Governor of Upper Canada at the time, **Sir Francis Bond Head**.



Having been a short time resident in Watertown and Rochester, the Governor of New York State would not release him for trial in Canada. Having violated the **US Neutrality Act** he was convicted of that crime and jailed in Rochester at the Blue Eagle Jail. He was later pardoned by US President Van Buren, 1840. William Lyon Mackenzie was able to return to Canada, and became a counselor for the City of York (Toronto).
